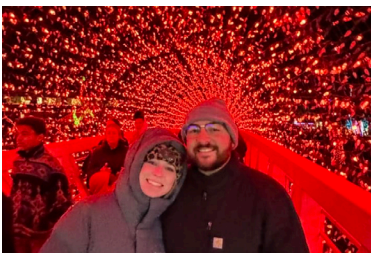

Christmas Lights Extravaganza at Rhema Bible College

Thousands of people visit the Rhema Christmas Lights display every year and witness over three million shimmering lights synchronized to Christmas music over Rhema's 110 acres. Rhema Christmas Lights Extravaganza is a brilliant display of twinkling lights that began with about 60,000 lights in 1982. Our Motorcoach will drive through the lights then we will get out and walk around the park (optional) to view the spectacular displays. Back again is the "Christmas tree forest." This year, it features a 22-foot tree, including a five-foot star, surrounded by smaller, beautifully lit metal trees. And as always, the vibrant Rhema Park bridge acts as a remarkable centerpiece for the entire display. Make sure to enjoy a photo-op at the Rhema Park bridge, complete with over 90,000 lights draped across the bridge alone. Synchronized to both classic and modern Christmas music, these lights delight visitors of all ages. While visiting the lights we can enjoy concessions (on your own) that include hot chocolate, piping hot coffee or sweet apple cider. Rhema's Christmas lights display was designed to provide a safe, peaceful, and fun atmosphere in which people can enjoy the Christmas season.
