

Day 4: Are you Ready for Some Football? We are headed to **Lambeau Field** home of the **Green Bay Packers!** Can you feel the indomitable spirit and impassioned energy that makes the Packers and Lambeau Field so endearing? On the Classic Stadium

Tour we will get to see one of Lambeau Field’s premium seating area and even go down to field level through the Player’s Tunnel, plus the exclusive end zone club levels. Along the way, we will learn about their historic organization and stadium. We will have time to visit the gift shop before we head to our next stop in Door County, Wisconsin. This afternoon we’ll enjoy our first of our Great Lake Boat Rides aboard **Sister Bay Scenic Boat Tours** on **Lake Michigan**. For dinner we will experience an authentic Door County tradition at **Pelletier’s Restaurant & Fish Boil**, a must-visit for any traveler seeking local flavor and charm. Located in the heart of Fish Creek, this iconic eatery offers a front-row seat to the dramatic fish boil process, where fresh whitefish is cooked to perfection over an open fire. Watch as the pot boils over in a spectacular blaze, a time-honored ritual that adds excitement to your meal. After the show/demonstration we will enjoy a delicious dinner paired with sides like red potatoes and coleslaw. Pelletier’s is more than a meal – it’s a unique cultural experience you won’t forget! **Overnight: Green Bay, Wisconsin (Night 2 of 2) (B, L, D)**

Day 5: Today is a Superior day as we immerse ourselves in the stunning natural beauty of **Pictured Rocks National Lakeshore** on **Lake Superior** with an unforgettable cruise aboard **Pictured Rocks Cruises**. The name “Pictured Rocks” comes from the vibrant sandstone cliffs adorned with unique colors and patterns, complemented by cascading waterfalls, hidden trails, and a lush, wooded river valley. The towering cliffs, some reaching up to 300 feet, are a breathtaking sight, along with the area’s iconic landmarks. Highlights of the cruise include the East Channel Lighthouse, Miners Castle, Lovers’ Leap, Indian Head, Grand Portal, Chapel Rock, and the majestic Spray Falls. **Overnight: Kewadin Shores Hotel Casino, St. Ignace, Michigan (Night 1 of 2-Night Stay) (B, L)**

Day 6: Rise and shine! This morning we board our motorcoach and travel to the St. Ignace Ferry Terminal where we will ferry across the Straits of Mackinac to **Mackinac Island**. The Straits of Mackinac is the connecting waterway between Lakes Michigan and Huron of the Great Lakes — the largest freshwater system on Earth. Next, we will experience the history, legends and beauty of Mackinac Island with a **horse-drawn carriage tour**. What a magnificent place Mackinac Island is – we will find no automobiles on the island only horse and buggy or bicycles. We will finish our tour at the beautiful and famous **Grand Hotel** where we will have a magnificent **buffet lunch**. Following lunch is free time to explore around the hotel then find your way back downtown via Taxi (carriage ride) at your leisure for our timed ferry ride back to our hotel in St. Ignace. **Overnight: Kewadin Shores Hotel Casino in St. Ignace, Michigan (Night 2 of 2) (B, L)**

Day 7: Welcome to “Little Bavaria” – Today, we’re off to the charming town of Frankenmuth, Michigan, affectionately known as “Little Bavaria”! Our first stop is a delightful lunch at **Zehnder’s of Frankenmuth**, a beloved American institution with a cozy, folksy atmosphere. Famous for their family-style fried chicken dinners, Zehnder’s recently earned the prestigious James Beard Foundation America’s Classics Award — a testament to their culinary excellence! This afternoon, we’ll set sail on **Huron Lady II Cruises** for a scenic journey on Lake Huron. Our adventure begins at the Black River in Port Huron, cruising south along the St. Clair River to admire the bustling River Walk and the freighter docks in Sarnia. We’ll then navigate north under the iconic Blue Water Bridges into Lake Huron, where we’ll see the historic Fort Gratiot Lighthouse, Michigan’s oldest operational lighthouse, and catch a glimpse of the legendary Huron Lightship. To top it all off, we’ll cross the border to say, “Welcome to Canada!” **Overnight: Point Edward, Ontario, Canada (B, L)**

Day 8: Today is **Lake Ontario** aboard the historical M.V. Chippewa III! We will enjoy a two-hour afternoon cruise. This cruise will highlight the history of the Niagara Region, the Welland Canal and the Niagara River and Lake Ontario. Next is a short drive to Niagara Falls where we’ll enjoy our next boat ride onboard the **Hornblower Catamaran Voyage to the Falls**. This unforgettable boat tour takes us up close to the American Falls, Bridal Veil Falls, and the powerful Horseshoe Falls. To end the day, enjoy a (optional) fireworks display with stunning views of the falls — a perfect finale to an incredible day! **Overnight: Niagara Falls, Ontario, Canada (B)**

Day 9: Today we have a big day planned in Niagara Falls. First, we are headed to the **Floral Clock & Butterfly Conservatory**. Next, we’ll go above the Falls to the **Skylon Tower** where we will enjoy the sights from Niagara’s highest and most spectacular viewpoint. At 775 feet above the Falls, this awe-inspiring panorama will take our breath away. We will ride one of the exterior glass-enclosed elevators to the Observation Deck. Did you know you could have lunch in the Skylon Tower? Yes! We can, and will enjoy the legendary Falls view while dining at the **Skylon Tower Revolving Dining Room**. What a day we will have in Niagara Falls! Before we say good-bye to Niagara Falls we will enjoy upclose photo-ops and shopping at **Goat Island** on the USA side of Niagara Falls. **Overnight: Erie, Pennsylvania (B, L)**

Day 10: Today we are going to have a Goodtime! Yes, we are! Because we are headed to Cleveland for our last boat ride to complete all of our boat rides on each of the Great Lakes! First we will enjoy our Skipper’s Luncheon Buffet dockside, followed by a tour learning about the amazing history of the city and enjoy spectacular views of downtown Cleveland, the Flats, and all of the surrounding areas with a two-hour, narrated cruise along the Cuyahoga River and **Lake Erie** onboard the **GOODTIME III!** **Overnight: Perrysburg, OH (B, L)**

Day 11: Today, we begin our journey towards home. We have a wonder lunch planned today in delightful Shipshewana, Indiana. We will have a little free-time for shopping then we are headed to an Amish Farm for a delicious home cooked meal with yummy homemade pies!!! 
