

## A JOURNEY THROUGH AMERICAN HISTORY!

*Trace America's evolution from colonial beginnings to national triumphs on a dynamic 14-day expedition through the East Coast's most iconic historic landscapes. Witness where the Civil War began at Fort Sumter, explore Charleston's preserved charm by carriage, follow the Outer Banks Scenic Byway past lighthouses and legends, and stand at the birthplace of powered flight. Travel onward to the roots of American democracy at Jamestowne, Williamsburg and Yorktown before experiencing the halls of government at the U.S. Capitol and the founding documents at the National Archives. Watch the morning flag being raised at Fort McHenry the site that inspired the writing of "The Star-Spangled Banner". Concluding with local guides telling stories of the battles at both Valley Forge, and Gettysburg! This tour is a moving tribute to the people and places that forged the 250 Year's of American History!*

**DAY 1:** This morning we begin our 14-day historic tour. Today is a Travel Day . . . remember, "Happiness is a way of travel . . . not just a destination" and with Travel Masters NWA, just being on the motorcoach is half the fun! (But it's even better knowing we have a meaningful itinerary ahead of us!) Today we will be getting to know fellow travelers, so sit back, relax and enjoy the scenery looking out the large windows of our spacious motor coach. **Overnight: Tupelo, Mississippi**

**Day 2:** Today, we have our first "Step back into History" experience at American Village where we will witness the birth of a nation! This evening's dinner is included enroute to our hotel. **Overnight: Conyers, Georgia (B, D)**

**Day 3:** Welcome to Charleston, South Carolina. This afternoon we'll enjoy a scenic narrated boat cruise across Charleston Harbor to Fort Sumter, where the first shots of the Civil War were fired. Step ashore to explore the historic island fort, walk its ramparts, and experience the powerful story of the nation's opening conflict in the place where history changed forever. Following our cruise we'll enjoy dinner. **Overnight: Charleston, South Carolina (B, D)**

**Day 4:** This morning we're heading downtown to the Big Red Barn - home to Palmetto Carriage Works and their horses that will take us on a Carriage ride of Charleston. During our one-hour, fully narrated tour through the streets of historic Charleston, our guide will recount the vibrant tale of the city's exquisite history. Next, we'll be headed north driving up the the coast where we have a delicious lunch planned. Hope you can handle the beach, because that's were we're headed next. Our beach-front hotel (and yes, we

are checking-in early for plenty of Rest & Relaxation on the beach! **Overnight: Surfside Beach, South Carolina (B, L)**

**Day 5:** Today, sleep in or enjoy sunrise on the beach this morning! We'll have a later departure to enjoy our hotel as long as possible. We're headed towards the Outer Bank's where we will explore the Coastline of North Carolina all day tomorrow! **Overnight: Kill Devil Hills, North Carolina (Night 1 of 2-Night Stay) (B)**

**Day 6:** Rise & Shine! We have a full day of sightseeing with our local guide! Today, we discover the Outer Banks of North Carolina. The Outer Banks are barrier islands off the coast of the U.S. state of North Carolina, separating the Atlantic Ocean from the mainland. Enjoy a full day of touring with a local step-on guide. We'll visit Wright Brothers National Memorial, The Lost Colony Museum, Bodie Island Lighthouse and Cape Hatteras Lighthouse along with several other photo-ops along the way! **Overnight: Kill Devil Hills, North Carolina (Night 2 of 2) (B)**

**Day 7:** The next few days we will be bringing the Revolutionary era to life! We will step into the story of America's fight for independence with a visit to the American Revolution Museum at Yorktown with interactive exhibits, immersive galleries, and living-history demonstrations! Next, is the Yorktown Battlefield Visitor Center where we can walk the historic grounds, see the fortifications, and learn about the decisive Siege of Yorktown that ended major combat in the Revolutionary War. Together, these experiences offer a vivid, hands-on understanding of the people, events, and strategies that shaped the birth of the United States. **Overnight: Williamsburg, Virginia (Night 1 of 2-Night Stay) (B, D)**





**Day 8:** Today we'll experience the heart of 18th-century America as you explore the streets, trades, and historic sites of Colonial Williamsburg, where costumed interpreters bring the fight for liberty to life. After our visit, enjoy an authentic colonial-style group dinner at Shields Tavern, featuring period-inspired dishes served in a warm and historic setting. This evening concludes with The Colonial Dance program at Colonial Williamsburg an immersive, interactive experience that bring 18th-century social life and culture to life through historic dancing. **Overnight: Williamsburg, Virginia (Night 2 of 2-Night Stay) (B, D)**

**Day 9:** Today, we'll discover the roots of America's first permanent English colony exploring both Jamestown Settlement and Historic Jamestowne. At Jamestown Settlement there is a life-sized replica of the colonists' fort, Powhatan Indian village, and ships bring the 1607 settlement to life through interactive exhibits and living-history presentations. At Historic Jamestowne, the original site of the colony, walk among the archaeological remains, view ongoing excavations, and reflect on the early struggles and achievements of the first settlers. Together, these two sites offer a comprehensive, hands-on experience of America's earliest days. **Overnight: Stafford, Virginia (B, L)**

**Day 10:** This morning we'll step into the heart of America's founding at the National Archives Museum, explore at your own pace. See the Magna Carta, Declaration of Independence, Constitution, and Bill of Rights — the priceless documents that shaped the nation — while enjoying exhibits that bring the story of American democracy to life. This experience offers a powerful, up-close connection to the ideals and history that continue to guide the United States today. Next we are headed to the Capitol Visitor Center and the US Capitol — The center welcomes visitors to the seat of American government. At nearly 580,000 square feet, the CVC is the largest project in the Capitol's 215-year history and is approximately three quarters the size of the Capitol itself. The entire facility is located underground on the east side of the Capitol so as not to detract from the appearance of the Capitol. Features include an exhibition gallery highlighting the House & Senate while in-session, orientation theaters, a 550-seat cafeteria, gift shops, and restrooms. We will have lunch (on your own) at the Capitol Visitor Center Cafeteria before our Capitol tour begins. **Overnight: Elkridge, Maryland (B)**

**Day 11:** Today we'll begin our day at Fort McHenry National Monument with the morning Flag Change Ceremony, a time-honored tradition that celebrates the enduring symbol of American freedom. We can explore the historic fort where the defense of Baltimore inspired Francis Scott Key to write "The Star-Spangled Banner," and enjoy the exhibits, ramparts, and scenic views of the harbor. Next, we're going to step back in time at Valley Forge National Historical Park with a guided tour that brings the Revolutionary War winter encampment to life. We will tour the grounds where General Washington and his troops endured harsh conditions, explore historic buildings, monuments, and memorials, and hear the stories of courage, perseverance, and sacrifice that shaped the birth of the United States. This immersive experience offers a powerful connection to America's fight for independence. **Overnight: Strasburg, Pennsylvania (B, D)**

**Day 12:** Today we visit Gettysburg National Military Park, the site of one of the most pivotal battles of the Civil War. At the Visitor Center, enjoy the award-winning film and the Gettysburg Cyclorama, an immersive oil painting longer than a football field and as tall as a four-story building. Enhanced with dramatic light and sound effects, the Cyclorama vividly depicts the intensity of Pickett's Charge on the third day of the battle. After some free time to explore the museum exhibits, we'll embark on a guided driving tour of the battlefield. An experienced guide will board our motorcoach to highlight key sites and share the fascinating history of the events that unfolded here. **Overnight: Bedford, Pennsylvania (B, L)**

**Day 13:** Our journey begins towards home. Taking in the beautiful spring colors, as we travel through Ohio and Indiana. Relax, reminisce, and share stories with fellow travelers about our adventures we've experienced and the new ones yet to come. **Overnight: Terre Haute, Indiana (B, L)**

**Day 14:** Farewell and Reflections! Today we conclude our Colonies & Coastline Tour and make our way home, carrying with us the unforgettable memories of historic sites, scenic coastlines, and immersive experiences. As we reflect on our journey, take a moment to think — which historical site inspired you the most? What a wonderful tour this was!
