Join the Travel Masters NWA as we visit Colorful Colorado!

DAY 1: All Aboard! This morning we begin our 7-Day Adventure to the Colorado Autumn Rails! We have a great tour planned in Colorado! This western U.S. state, has a diverse landscape of arid desert, river canyons and of course, beautiful Rocky Mountains! But this year is a great time to see their Aspen Trees! The beautiful aspen is the quintessential Colorado tree. They have named towns, streets, dogs and even beer after this glorious tree. We have planned this tour for the peak viewing time of the Aspens! It's a spectacular sight as "Mother Nature" turns the foliage beautiful colors for us to enjoy! Today is a travel day to get us well on our way! It's also a great day to get acquainted with fellow travelers. We can sit back, relax, and enjoy the scenery looking out the large windows of our spacious motor coach. Tonight is our first chuckwagon dinner! Delicious!

Day 2: Welcome to Colorado! Today marks the first of four unforgettable train experiences on our journey — aboard the Royal Gorge Route Railroad! Listen closely and you might hear the conductor shout, "ALL ABOARD!" The Royal Gorge Route Railroad takes us deep into North America's most breathtaking canyon. Towering granite walls, the roaring Arkansas River, and up-close views we can almost touch! Step into the open-air cars, feel the wind, and watch for bighorn sheep and soaring eagles beneath Colorado's blue skies. **Overnight: Colorado Springs, Colorado Night 1 of 2-Night Stay (B)**

Day 3: Today is a great day to be inspired! First, we are headed to visit and tour the Garden of the Gods in Colorado Springs. The Garden of the Gods Visitor & Nature Center is the most visited attraction in the Pikes Peak region, offering iconic views, new interactive museum exhibits, shopping, and the fun and exciting Geo-Trekker Theater movie experience. Next, we're headed to the Pikes Peak Cog Railway – where we will ascend to the summit of

America's Mountain aboard the Broadmoor Manitou & Pikes Peak Cog Railway — the highest cog railway in the United States. Since 1891, this legendary mountain train has carried adventurers from the charming town of Manitou Springs up to the breathtaking 14,115-foot summit of Pikes Peak, traversing nearly 9 miles of scenic wonder through forests, alpine tundra, cascading waterfalls, historic sites, and dramatic rock formations. Did you know they just completed a multi-year, \$100 million upgrade, the entire railway was rebuilt with new track infrastructure and a modern Strub single-rail cog system for smoother, more reliable service. Three brand-new trainsets from Switzerland join refurbished railcars to provide greater capacity, comfort, and safety. This evening we will step back into the spirit of the Old West at the Flying W Ranch Chuckwagon Dinner & Show, a beloved Colorado Springs tradition nestled in the scenic foothills. Enjoy a hearty, authentic chuckwagon meal served with Western hospitality, followed by an award-winning live music and comedy show that celebrates cowboy life, frontier history, and patriotic favorites. With toe-tapping music, family-friendly fun, and unforgettable views of the surrounding mountains, the Flying W Ranch offers an evening of genuine Western charm and entertainment. **Overnight: Colorado Springs, Colorado Night 2 of 2-Night Stay (B, D)**

Day 4: This afternoon we are headed to board the Leadville Colorado & Southern Railroad, a spectacular railroad journey in the Rocky Mountains with incredible views of Colorado's two highest peaks, plus colorful wildflowers and majestic and colorful aspen groves. We will escape thru the wilderness while enjoying an on board narrative of Leadville's colorful past! Expect color! Last time we visited this train the colors were popping! **Overnight: Gunnison, Colorado (B)**



Day 5: Morning, Glory! It's going to be a glorious day! Silverton, a National Historic Landmark nestled at 9,318 feet, is a true gem of the San Juan Mountains. Part of the breathtaking San Juan Skyway and connected to Ouray by the legendary Million Dollar Highway, Silverton blends dramatic alpine scenery with charming Victorian character. Founded during the Colorado mining boom after gold was discovered in 1860, the town flourished with the arrival of the Denver & Rio Grande Railroad in 1882 — now known as the Durango & Silverton Narrow Gauge Railroad. Traveling south from Ouray, we'll cross spectacular Red Mountain Pass, sitting back to enjoy jaw-dropping views from the comfort of our motorcoach. Upon arrival in Silverton, enjoy lunch on your own before we call "All Aboard!" for an unforgettable journey aboard the historic Durango & Silverton Narrow Gauge Railroad. This family-friendly steam train ride relives the sights and sounds of the Old West while showcasing pristine mountain scenery inaccessible by highway. In continuous operation since 1882, this iconic railroad proves that while it once hauled silver and gold, it's the views that remain truly priceless. **Overnight: Durango, Colorado (B)**

Day 6: This morning, we board our motorcoach and travel through a landscape unlike anything we've seen over the past week. We'll stop in Albuquerque for lunch on your own, then continue east to Amarillo for our overnight stay. This evening, we'll gather for a delicious steak dinner, celebrating our final night of this unforgettable tour. **Overnight: Amarillo, Texas (B, D)**
