**DAY 1:** It's Time for a New Adventure with Travel Masters NWA! This morning we begin our 14-Day Adventure to the New England States! This is full of "Our Favorite Things" from the New England States and will be a great adventure for everyone! Our travels to the New England States are packed with interesting stops you're sure to love! As everyone knows, part of the fun of our tours are the great times we have on the road heading to our destinations. We'll be getting to know fellow travelers, so sit back, relax and enjoy the scenery looking out the large windows of our spacious motor coach. Today is a travel day to get us well on our way! **Overnight: Effingham, Illinois (L)**

**DAY 2:** Rise & Shine! Today we take flight into history at the National Museum of the United States Air Force in Dayton, Ohio, the world's oldest and largest military aviation museum! Explore over 19 acres of exhibits featuring more than 350 aerospace vehicles, from iconic World War II bombers to cutting-edge stealth aircraft. Marvel at the impressive Presidential and Space Galleries, walk through historic aircraft, and experience the thrill of flight simulators. **Overnight: Cambridge, OH (B)**



**DAY 3:** Today we'll visit the Flight 93 National Memorial to honor the courage and sacrifice of those who fought to protect others on September 11, 2001. The peaceful 2,200-acre site features a thoughtful Visitor Center with exhibits and a short film, the contemplative Wall of Names and Memorial Plaza marking the crash site, and the soaring Tower of Voices — a 93-pipe musical tribute that sings with the wind. Scenic walking trails guide you across the sacred landscape to interpretive overlooks, while rangers and self-guided materials provide personal stories and historical context. Plan for quiet reflection and a moving, solemn experience that connects history, landscape, and memory. We will end our day with a delicious group dinner at Miller's Smorgasbord. **Overnight: Strasburg, Pennsylvania (B, D)**

**DAY 4:** Welcome to Maine! Today we'll travel from Pennsylvania through New Jersey, New York, and Connecticut before continuing on to Maine. This afternoon we'll check in for a two-night stay at The Anchorage Inn in York, perfectly situated directly across from the ocean for refreshing sea breezes and stunning views. Dinner this evening will be served at a local restaurant. **Overnight: Anchorage Inn in York Beach, Maine (B, D) Night 1 of 2 Night Stay**

**DAY 5:** This morning, we head to charming Perkins Cove in Ogunquit to board the Finestkind III for a scenic Nubble Lighthouse Cruise. This delightful boat ride traces Maine's southern coastline from Ogunquit to York Harbor, offering breathtaking views of York's elegant oceanfront homes and dramatic rocky shores. We'll cruise leisurely to the iconic Nubble Lighthouse (also known as Cape Neddick Light), one of Maine's most photographed beacons. Be sure to bring your camera — the highlight comes as we circle the seldom-seen back side of the lighthouse, providing stunning, unique photo opportunities you won't find from shore. Next, we continue to Kennebunkport for free time for lunch and shopping (On Your Own) in lively Dock Square. After lunch, we will join our local guide for tour of Kennebunkport and Kennebunk, two historic shipbuilding villages along Maine's picturesque south coast. As we drive, you'll hear captivating history and folklore, including tales of sea captains and shipbuilders. Highlights include passing beautiful beaches, the legendary Wedding Cake House (famous for its ornate, confection-like design), and a scenic drive along Ocean Avenue. We'll pass the Bush family's summer home at Walker's Point, then visit the serene Franciscan Monastery (St. Anthony's), with its peaceful seaside shrine. We return to Ogunquit for a relaxing dinner this evening at a local restaurant before returning to our hotel for the night. **Overnight: Anchorage Inn in York Beach, Maine (B, D) Night 2 of 2 Night Stay**

**DAY 6:** Let's explore Maine some more! This morning, we head to Portland, Maine's largest and most dynamic city-by-the-sea where we will meet our knowledgeable local guide. Our tour includes a stop at the iconic Portland Head Light, widely regarded as America's most photographed lighthouse. This historic 1791 beacon stands dramatically in Fort Williams Park in nearby Cape Elizabeth, offering breathtaking panoramic views of the rugged coast and crashing Atlantic waves. For lunch, (On Your Own) enjoy free time in Portland's charming Old Port district (also known as the Old Port Exchange). This beautifully restored 19th-century waterfront area features classic cobblestone streets lined shops and restaurants. This afternoon, relax and enjoy the scenic ride "Downeast" to enchanting Bar Harbor, the welcoming gateway to Acadia National Park. Perched atop a hill overlooking a picturesque harbor filled with tour boats, fishing vessels, and occasional grand cruise ships, Bar Harbor offers a delightful blend





of small-town charm with vibrant streets of shops and eateries. We'll check into the scenic Atlantic Oceanside Hotel for a two-night stay. This oceanfront resort sits on 12 acres of coastal property with stunning views of Frenchman Bay. Just one mile from downtown Bar Harbor, it features guest rooms with water views, private balconies or patios. We will cap off the day with an included traditional Maine lobster dinner — complete with all the classic fixings! **Overnight: 2-Night Stay in Bar Harbor, Maine (B, D) Night 1 of 2 Night Stay**

**DAY 7:** Rise & Shine! We can vouch that it's worth getting up for sunrise here! (See the photo in the top left we took it the last time we were here). This morning, we will meet our local guide for a guided morning tour of Bar Harbor and Acadia National Park. Bar Harbor has been celebrated for its breathtaking beauty ever since the island was discovered in 1604 by Samuel de Champlain, who named it "Isle de Monts Desert" (Mt. Desert Island) for its bare, desert-like mountaintops. You'll see tremendous coastline views that have attracted the elite to this area for years. Our guide will tell stories of the Victorian "rusticators", more recent visitors and famous residents. Highlights of this tour include the stunning Loop Road, the summit of Cadillac Mountain, the crashing waves at Thunder Hole and quiet beauty of the inland park scenery. Enjoy an included box lunch at Jordan Pond during your Acadia Tour before returning to the resort to enjoy free time on your own this afternoon. This afternoon, enjoy time on your own to explore Bar Harbor; wandering the shops, museums, and art galleries, or walking the shoreline trails and enjoying the beautiful surroundings. Dinner will be (On Your Own) this evening in the village or back at the hotel. **Overnight: Bar Harbor, Maine (B, L)**

**DAY 8:** Up and at em' this morning as we depart Bar Harbor and head to North Conway New Hampshire. Upon arrival we'll board the train to ride the rails through the North Conway area and experience the area's mountain and valley beauty aboard the Mountaineer: The "Mountaineer" (formerly known as The Notch Train) journeys past some of the finest natural scenery in the East - sheer bluffs, steep ravines, cascading brooks and streams, wide mountain vistas and across the famous Frankenstein Trestle and Willey Brook Bridge, both engineering marvels of the early 20th century. A box lunch will be included to enjoy during our train ride. Next, we'll continue our journey to Jackson, New Hampshire to check in to The Eagle Mountain House, a restored turn-

of-the-century country inn. We'll enjoy the beautiful mountain views from the 280-foot wrap-around verandah before heading into our dinner that is included at the Hotel this evening. **Overnight: Eagle Mountain House, Jackson, New Hampshire (B, L, D)**

**DAY 9:** Let's go to the Mountain Top! This morning we are headed to the Stowe Mountain Resort for a Gondola ride to see the scenic views of the mountains and valleys as we ride to the top of Mount Mansfield. A spacious observation deck provides vistas of Stowe, the Green Mountains and beyond. Next, is "One of my Favorite Things", a visit to the Trapp Family Lodge "The Hills are alive with the Sound of Music" is what everyone thinks of when they visit the Trapp Family Lodge. Enjoy a sumptuous buffet lunch plus panoramic views of Vermont's Green Mountains. After lunch we will enjoy a guided 90-minute tour of the Lodge and grounds. The von Trapp family's journey is a remarkable story. In 1938, just before WWII, the Baron and Baroness von Trapp left all their possessions and estate near Salzburg, Austria. With nine children and one on the way, they fled Austria and were granted asylum in the US. Arriving with four dollars, they settled in Philadelphia and through their music, turned a family hobby into a profession as the Trapp Family Singers. They soon bought a small farmhouse in Stowe, Vermont, because the landscape reminded them of home. Here the family lived peacefully and continued to travel the world singing. They rented out rooms at their farmhouse to skiers and ran the Trapp Family Music Camp. Maria wrote an autobiography that inspired the play and movie, "The Sound of Music" and her story became an American legend. Next we'll make our way to beautiful Middlebury Vermont where we will check in to the historic Middlebury Inn for an overnight stay and dinner. We can look out over the town from the front porch and experience a place that's been a part of Vermont's history since 1827. **Overnight: Middlebury Inn, Middlebury, Vermont (B, L, D)**
